The aim of the Green Deal is to improve the energy efficiency of more than 14 million UK properties by 2020. The Green Deal enables property owners to install energy efficiency improvements at no upfront cost*, with the costs incurred being recouped through savings on energy bills, through the bill itself. The Green Deal is not an advance payment or personal loan and therefore no obligation follows the property owner should they move.

What is the Energy Company Obligation (ECO)

Energy Company Obligation (ECO) is a Government backed funding stream that offers grants towards a broad range of energy saving measures. Also known as ECO, the Energy Company Obligation offers funding for energy efficiency improvements in three main streams:

- The Carbon Saving Community Obligation (CSCO)
- The Home Heating Cost Reduction Obligation (HCRO)
- The Carbon Emission Reduction Obligation (CERO)

Properties or families may be eligible for fully or partially funded energy efficiency improvements through these streams. Please contact us for more information.

The PAS 2030 certification gives you access to the Green Deal and Energy Company Obligation (ECO), both provide exciting prospects for the installer. Through the Eco scheme the six large energy companies are obligated to invest around £1.3 billion a year. This, and the Green Deal, give your customers a new way to pay, without the need for large upfront investments or an expensive personal loan. This means more work for you and reliable, guaranteed payments.
